a) EMAIL

MINIMUM COACHING REQUIREMENTS

All coaches must have taken the Competitive Introduction Women's Field Lacrosse course, completed the Evaluation Workbook, In-Person Evaluation, and online Make Ethical Decisions Module, and receive written confirmation that this requirement has been met by the CLA Program Coordinator no later than December 31, 2011.
